

Fitting Instructions for Dishwasher adapter

It is extremely important that the dishwasher is connected to the cold water supply as some are connected to the hot water supply, you will need to check.



Shown here is the hose to the dishwasher removed and the adapter installed. The adapter is supplied with 3 rubber washers to ease installation. The adapter has a threaded port in the side of the adapter. The operation of the dishwasher will be unaffected.



Shown here is the in-line ball valve, dishwasher hose and John Guest fitting installed. This type of set-up is used for the white in-line pressure limiting valve. When installing the ball valve, 4 wraps of thread tape (supplied) are applied to the male end in a clockwise direction when the fitting is held in the left hand. 4 wraps of thread tape are applied to the grey John Guest fitting and screwed into the female port of the ball valve.



When the Filtermate pressure limiting valve is used the valve screws directly into the ball valve.



When the RMC brass pressure limiting valve is used the valve screws via 1/2" to 1/4" brass nipple into the ball valve.

If any leaks are detected from any of the fittings, simply unscrew and apply a little more thread tape. Apply small amounts of thread tape at a time as too much applied at a time is worse than too little. **A roll of thread tape is supplied with each filter unit.**
