

# Fitting instructions for Braided line fitting



This is a braided line and normally used to connect a flick mixer type tap to the mains supply. Braided hoses are normally fitted finger tight, if you do use multi-grips to tighten, do so gently as excess pressure is not required. Remember to turn off the water supply.



This photo shows the braided line adapter fitted. All that is required is to unscrew the braided line off the mains supply and install the adapter, which has a threaded port coming out the side of the fitting. This adapter has a compression washer and thread tape is not normally required



The in-line ball valve screws directly into the adapter and 4 wraps of thread tape (supplied) are applied to the male threads in a clockwise direction.



When the white in-line pressure limiting valve is used the grey John Guest fitting is screwed into the female port of the ball valve using 4 wraps of thread tape.



When the Filtermate pressure limiting valve is used the valve screws directly into the ball valve.



When the RMC brass pressure limiting valve is used the valve screws via 1/2" to 1/4" brass nipple into the ball valve.

If any leaks are detected from any of the fittings, simply unscrew and apply a little more thread tape. Apply small amounts of thread tape at a time as too much applied at a time is worse than too little. A roll of thread tape is supplied with each filter unit.
